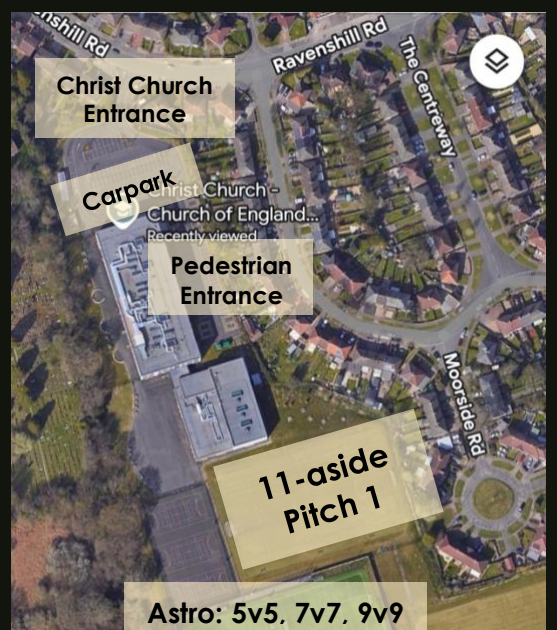

### - Key information (what we offer)

As well as our pitches and facilities, we provide an on-site café, serving hot food, hot drinks, cold drinks, and other snacks – accessible by all.

We have toilets available, both in the school and in our clubhouse – easily accessible for all players, coaches, parents, spectators etc..

We also have plenty of free parking at both venues. Carparks are accessible and within walking distance of our pitches.

Gates are usually open from 9:30am on both sides, closing times will vary weekly depending on the kick off times of our final games.

A member of the club's committee will be on-site every weekend to ensure smooth operation. **Please do not hesitate to reach out if they can be of assistance.**

### - Visitor policy (what we expect from you)



**NO DOGS** are allowed at Maypole FC or Christ Church Secondary School in the interest of player safety. Please do not arrive with dogs as you could be refused entry (with the exception of guide dogs).



**NO SMOKING / VAPING** at Christ Church Secondary School under any circumstances. This is permitted at our Maypole FC ground but not on the pitch or technical areas of coaches to ensure player safety remains a priority.
